Later on in this newsletter there's a little tutorial to help you add yourself as a member and how to see the calendar.

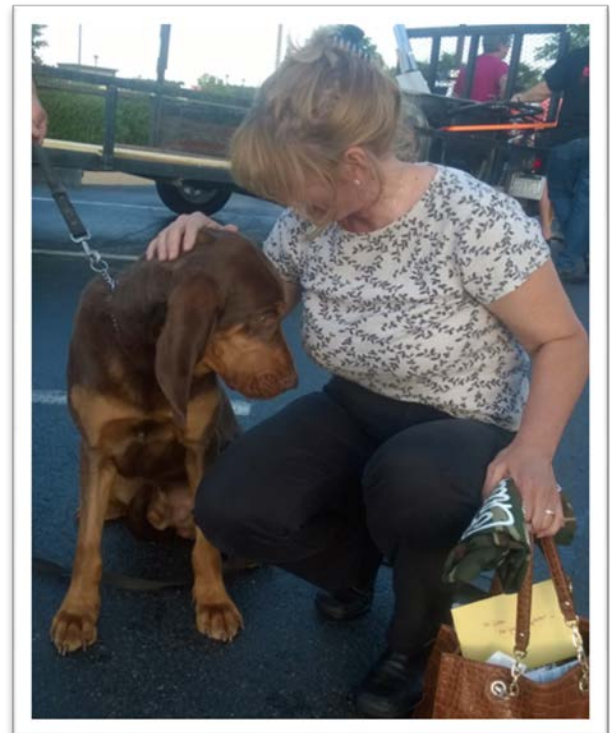

The GFKC Sheriffs' K-9 Fund Raising Initiative is Going Great

The Club is buying everything direct from the manufacturers who are giving us very generous discounts. This way we can rest assured that the money is going for the purpose intended.

Here's the low-down:

K-9 units from Stafford County, Spotsylvania County, King George County, and the City of Fredericksburg will all benefit from this fundraiser. Collectively, there are 18 K-9 teams; each team was interviewed to assess their needs. Aside from Stafford County, which has three teams, the remaining teams had either vests that had expired or had no vests at all.



So far we have purchased ballistic vests for the King George dogs, a new training “bite” suit for all teams to share, cooling vests for each dog on every team, GO-PRO cameras to be attached to the ballistic vests in special situations as well as other requested items.



The Stafford Dog Club donated ballistic vests for Stafford. Most of Spotsylvania’s vests were privately donated and PALS did a fundraiser for new ballistic vests for the City of Fredericksburg



The Chick-Fil-A fundraiser was a big hit with the public. The officers explained their mission and showed them the dogs. It was very exciting and educational.

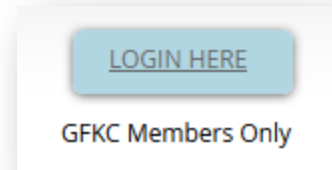

In order to see the information posted in the Member Area. You need to enter your email address and create a password for yourself. Look on the GFKC Home page for...




...and click on LOGIN HERE.


