


From Washington, DC: Take US-1 South/14th St. Bridge. US-1 becomes 1-395 South. 1-395 South becomes 1-95 South. Take the VA 30 Exit, Exit 98 toward Doswell/West Point. Turn left onto VA-30 Exit/Kings Dominion Boulevard. Follow approximately 1.8 miles to The Meadow Event Park. Use Gate #3.

From Fredericksburg, VA: Take VA-3 West to 1-95. Merge onto 1-95 South toward Richmond. Take the VA-30 Exit, Exit 98 toward Doswell/West Point. Turn left onto VA-30 Exit/Kings Dominion Boulevard. Follow approximately 1.8 miles to The Meadow Event Park. Use Gate #3.

RV PARKING INFORMATION

- RVs may arrive on the grounds to park after 12:00 Noon Wednesday, August 20, 2025.
- Pre-reserved RV Parking is \$60.00 per night per space. Reservations are available on a first come, first served basis. Priority is given to reservations for five nights - Wednesday through Sunday.
- RV parking space after deadline or on site with no reservation - \$70.00 Per Night. No arrivals after 10:00 P.M.
- Overnight RV parking will be in assigned spaces and only one vehicle permitted per space. A tow unit with a trailer is considered one vehicle.
- RV sites are equipped with electric & water. However, it is strongly suggested to arrive with the ability to be self contained if necessary (including but not limited to a site power outage etc.)
- No waste or gray water may be discharged onto the grounds.
- If you wish to park next to a particular party, make a note in the space in the online reservation form.
- No cones or other means of saving space will be allowed unless directed by Site Control personnel.
- Overnight parking is a privilege extended by The Meadow Event Park and the Cluster Clubs. No abusive or argumentative language will be permitted. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry on the entry form.

Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS.

Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book and the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner.

Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.*

The Get MUST be entered in one of the Regular Classes. The Stud Dog unit shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee. The Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with his Get. Get are only to be judged on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if he has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for the Breed.

***NR2.09200.* Brood Bitch Class** - Same as Stud Dog except substitute "Brood Bitch" for "Stud Dog" and "Produce" for "Get."

***NR2.09300.* Brace Class** - Two dogs of the same breed or variety and must have at least one common owner and presented by a maximum of two handlers. - The dogs comprising a Brace MUST be named at the time of the entry. If a dog that is to be a part of a Brace is not entered in another class, it must be marked "For Brace Only." In making an entry for "Brace Class Only," full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes: "Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH Brace must be so designated: Brace No. 1, Brace No. 2, etc.

As the judges' decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch & Brace Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, none of the dogs or bitches making up the entry which are judged first will be eligible for Best of Breed or Variety by virtue of having won these classes.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. 5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
